

Summer 2016 Results for Churchill Community College

The results below are the latest results for our students reaching the age of 16. They represent a continuously improving trend over the last four year. You will notice that our performance compared with all other schools nationally is significantly above average. In terms of the progress there is a new performance measure called 'Progress 8' this compares the progress of all students nationally based on their results in eight qualifications from a combination of English, maths, science, history geography, language, computer science and option subjects, our score puts us in the top 30% of schools nationally.
